Genesis 22:1-19 • The Shadow of the Cross

- 1. (v.1-3) What takes place between Abraham and Isaac and replayed between the Father and the Son is found in the repeated phrase, "your son, your only son".
- 2. (v.4-8) It takes place on the **third** day with the son bearing the **wood** to the hill for his own **sacrifice**.
- 3. (v.9-14) Isaac prefigures <u>Christ</u> by going from death to life, but prefigures each of <u>us</u> in that God provides a personal <u>sacrifice</u> in our <u>place</u>.
- 4. (v.15-19) The promises to Abraham for his <u>obedience</u> prefigure the promises to come through <u>Christ</u> for His obedience.

This is the first biblical use of the terms "<u>test</u>", "<u>love</u>", "<u>worship</u>" and "<u>obey</u>", which as applied correctly through Abraham result in "now I know that you <u>fear</u> God".
