1.	(v.25-32) The true role of a prophet is to point to <u>God</u> . The goal of revelation given to a prophet is to turn <u>hearts</u> to <u>God</u> .
2.	(v.33-36) One must relinquish sole <u>power</u> over one's life, submitting to the direction and authority of <u>Christ</u> to address every <u>issue</u> in one's life.
3.	(v.37-45) Exultation is something that is effected by <u>God</u> in the course of our carrying out <u>His work</u> and it is always for <u>His purposes.</u>
4.	(v.46-49) Our work is always to stand in <u>service</u> before the <u>King</u> to carry out <u>His commands</u> .
5.	(v.53-57) It always and ultimately comes down to the Word.
