Genesis 46-47 • Jacob's Last Journey

- (46:1-7) We not only seek God's guidance and blessing when it appears there is no obvious way out of <u>adversity</u>, but even when provided an opportunity for what looks like <u>safety</u> and <u>prosperity</u>.
- 2. (46:28-34) We must go to the place prepared by **Christ** so that we may effectively live **IN** the **world** but not **OF** the **world**.
- (47:1-12) When we are living in the world but exclusively
 according to His Word and ways, the visible <u>testimony</u> of God's
 blessing to us in turn makes us a visible <u>testimony</u> and blessing
 to the <u>unsaved</u>.
- 4. (47:13-22) The work of the Messiah in this life is to facilitate our bringing everything, even our physical being, into complete and total submission to the Father.
- 5. (47:23-26) Salvation is worked out in the course of **submission**:
 - We plant His <u>seed</u> in the land—do the work of God's Word in the <u>world</u>;
 - We feed our <u>household</u>—do the work of God's Word in the Body of Christ;
 - We give God His <u>tithe</u>—we supply the <u>resources</u> for the working of God's Word.
- 6. (47:27-31) Whether by death and Resurrection or by the onetime supernatural event we call the Rapture, we will permanently leave the <u>life</u> of the <u>world</u> for the <u>promise</u> of <u>eternity</u> with Christ.
