Exodus 2 • Moses' First Calling

- 1. (Ex. 2:1-10) Through the deliverer comes <u>salvation</u>, God's <u>Word</u>, and the way to <u>the Promised Land</u>.
- 2. (Ac. 7:17-21) Jesus is the fulfillment of Dt. 18:18:
 - a. The fulfillment of God's promise of salvation.
 - b. Came when Israel was under an oppressor.
 - c. **Born** under the sentence of death.
 - d. Rejected by Jews, accepted by Gentiles.
- 3. (Ex. 2:11-15) Moses' took matters into his own hands.
- 4. (Ac. 7:22-29) Moses "became an alien" to his people.
- 5. (Ex. 2:16-22) Moses is initially rejected and takes a **Gentile** bride.
- 6. (Ex. 2:23-25) Before **physical** salvation could take place, **spiritual** salvation had to first take place.
- 7. (Ac. 7:35) Moses' calling could not be accomplished without Christ.
