

Exodus 14 • The Final Sign of the Exodus

- (v.1-4) On the one side were the **false gods of Egypt**, on the other the **false gods of Canaan**. Israel would have to pass through both to come to the **One True God**.
 - “Pi-hahiroth” = “**house of the Egyptian goddess Hiroth**”
 - “Migdo” = “**watch tower**”
 - “Baal-zaphor” = “**Baal of the North**”
- (v.5-9) Pharaoh goes from being personally **passive** to **actively** participating – just like **the Antichrist**.
- (v.10-14) It is the Lord Who **fights the battle** – just like **Armageddon**.
- (v.15-18) In times of trial the believer must move as **God directs**, which is always towards **His glory and honor**.
- (v.19-25) What leads to **light** and **life** in Christ for those who accept Him are the very things that bring **darkness** and **death** for those who reject Him – just as in **the Last Days**.
- (v.25-31) The Egyptians’ final acknowledgment of God was not enough to save them because it came as the result of **fighting** Him, not **submitting** to Him – just like **Final Judgment**.

Overall Applications:

- The greater thing that all legitimate signs and wonders point to is **salvation**. The signs confirm the **message**.
- That message for non-Believers is the Gospel of **salvation**; for Believers it’s faith and trust in Him to **complete** the work of **salvation**.
- Baptism is not simply exchanging one set of gods for another set, but completely leaving **the old life** and trusting Him for **the new**.
