Exodus 35:4-36:7 • Plans for the Plunder

1.	(Gen. 15:12-14; 3:19-22; 12:35-36) There is a <u>cooperative</u> effort which is required, both God's providential <u>intervention</u> and His people's <u>obedience</u> .
2.	(Ex. 25:1-9) There purpose of the literal Old Testament gifts are a shadow of the ultimate purpose of the New Testament spiritual gifts—"construct a sanctuary for Me". (Eph. 4:8-13)
3.	(Ex. 35:4-9, 20-29) Although the possessions were obtained as a part of God's plan, they had to be voluntarily contributed from the heart.

4. (Ex. 36:2-7) The best thing is to make God's plan for our

possessions our <u>plan</u>.
