Leviticus 16:2-34 • Into the Holy of Holies

- 1. (v.2-10) Christ Himself represents:
 - a. The <u>High Priest</u> making the sacrifice, a common man without <u>sin</u>.
 - b. The sacrifice itself, whose blood is shed for sin.
 - c. The <u>scapegoat</u> for which <u>sins</u> are removed from the camp (mankind).

2. (v.11-28) Through Christ, our High Priest, all our <u>sins</u> are removed and "<u>sent away</u>".

3. (v.29-34) Coming into the presence of Christ requires both **personal** and **corporate** confession of **sin**.
