## Deuteronomy 7 • Dealing with the Enemy

- 1. (v.1-2) We are not to enter into any kind of <u>relationship</u> with adherents of <u>cults</u> or other <u>religions</u>.
- 2. (v.3-5) We are not to enter into <u>personal relationships</u> with members of cults or other religions.
- 3. (v.6-8) We are called by God to be **separate** from the world.
- 4. (v.9-11) To successfully separate from the enemy and fulfill God's calling is accomplished by <u>obedience to His Word</u>.
- 5. (v.12-16) Sometimes persecution comes because of <u>evil</u> in the world, and sometimes because of believers' <u>disobedience</u>.
- 6. (v.17-21) We're not supposed to be satisfied with the status quo but with completely <u>overcoming</u> and <u>removing</u> false spiritual influences.
- 7. (v.22-26) It really comes down to a <u>spiritual battle</u> for the heart, mind and soul. (2 Cor. 7:1; Rom. 13:14)
