Joshua 2 • The Covenant with Rahab

- 1. Rahab starts out exactly as WE start out.
- 2. God provided an extended period of grace, many centuries of opportunity for them to repent and be saved.
- All witnessed the <u>signs</u> of God, but the remnant responded the <u>right way</u>, whereas the <u>condemned</u> steadfastly refused to change their ways in time.
- The proper response to God's Word (and signs) is <u>faith</u> and <u>commitment</u> to God's Word.
- 5. Faith is not merely believing the <u>truth</u> of God's Word that's only the first step. Faith is proved by taking <u>action</u> on those beliefs.
- 6. When people trust Christ, their first desire will be to <u>share</u> it with <u>others</u>, especially their own <u>family</u>. (Jn. 1:35-42; Mk. 5:18-20)
- 7. Rahab and her loved ones were protected from the <u>wrath</u> of God's judgment.
- 8. Rahab, like all believers, goes to a wedding feast.
