Joshua 4:19-5:15 • The Spiritually Prepared Generation

- (4:19-24) To non-believers signs are to establish the <u>power</u> and <u>authority</u> of God, to believers they are to evoke <u>reverence</u> and <u>worship</u>. Both, in their own way, testify to God's <u>glory</u>.
- (5:1) The working of God either <u>converts</u> non-believers or <u>convicts</u> them. It is possible for some to witness God's work, even attribute it to Him, and still remain <u>unchanged</u> from the heart where it matters.
- 3. (5:2-9) The right example and intent of circumcision is to undergo a **physical** act as a reflection of an inward **spiritual** condition.
- 4. (5:10-12) God's provision of God's people is always supplied through His **Word**.
- (5:13-15) Christ always leads and works both <u>internally</u> (the heart) and <u>externally</u> (God's kingdom) on behalf of the spiritually <u>prepared</u>.
