Joshua 22:1-6 • Obedience Before, During, and After

- 1. (Num. 32:5-12) The issue is maintaining a right relationship with **BOTH** God and man.
- 2. (Numb. 32:20-24) A saving faith in Christ is accompanied by **promises** which we are obligated, on our part, to **keep**.
- 3. (Josh. 1:16-18) Obedience is not just required **personally**, but **collectively**.
- (Josh. 4:10-13) The promise of obedience at the point of <u>salvation</u> has to be followed through as we engage in our <u>service</u> to God.
- 5. (Josh. 22:1-4) Biblical obedience is proven in the course of obedience to both <u>God</u> and <u>man</u>.
- (Josh. 22:5-6) Biblical obedience is proven by our adherence to <u>God's Word</u> even when our leaders or brethren are not <u>present</u>.
