Judges 1-2 • When God's People Fail

1. (1:1-36) One of the mistakes believers make is the false notion that they can <u>control</u> or <u>inhibit</u> the <u>bad</u> spiritual influences which aren't supposed to be allowed in the first place. If you can't <u>overcome</u> the enemy, you won't be able to ultimately <u>control</u> or <u>limit</u> them either.

2. (2:1-10) Obedience to God's Word and ways has to be <u>passed</u> from one generation to the next. There is no "<u>automatic</u>" inclusion based on <u>heritage</u> and <u>history</u> alone.

 (2:11-23) <u>Tolerating</u> bad spiritual influences accelerated by <u>disobedience</u> to God's Word did not merely result in occasional problems with sin, but led to purposely <u>breaking</u> the promise and commitment they made with the Lord to begin with.
