## 1 Samuel 5-6 • When God Defends His Name

1.	(5:1-5) God will not reveal His power on behalf of His sinning people, but neither will an enemy be allowed to mock His glory or defile His name.
2.	(5:6-12) The repeated and continual rejection of God's signs and message inevitably leads to the wrath of God's judgment.
3.	(6:1-12) Spiritual issues are always a reflection of the condition of one's <a href="heart">heart</a> , whether it is willing to repent and submit to the authority of God or is <a href="heart">hardened</a> in disobedience and therefore must experience God's escalating <a href="judgment">judgment</a> .
4.	(6:13-18) Signs always have a dual working for believers and non-believers alike.

5. (6:19-21) The same consequences of God's judgment are experienced by everyone who does not submit to His <u>authority</u>, operate according to His <u>Word</u>, and treat Him as <u>holy</u>.
