1 Samuel 18 • The Greater Test of Faith

 (v.1-5) As with all leaders of God, David was tested in the course of his <u>popularity</u>. If someone cannot love on a <u>personal</u> level, they will not effectively love at the <u>corporate</u> level when carrying out their ministry and calling.

2. (v.6-11) David's practice of love led to <u>faithfulness</u> while Saul's lack of love led to <u>unfaithfulness</u>.

3. (v.12-16) It takes faith to experience a <u>demotion</u> in the eyes of everyone around us and still maintain our <u>humility</u> and <u>service</u>.

 (v.17-30) David's faith was tested in the presence of <u>disappointment</u>, first in the person of <u>Saul</u> who did not keep his word, then by the <u>wife</u> David ultimately was given.
