2 Samuel 6 • Restoring God's Word

- 1. (v.1-11) David displeases the Lord.
 - a. Mistake #1: He consults men instead of God.
 - b. Mistake #2: He forsakes God's ways for the world's ways.
 - c. Mistake #3: He places **people** in harm's way.
 - d. Result: Uncorrected <u>error</u> always leads to further and more serious <u>error</u>.
- 2. (v.12-19) David displays his zeal for the Lord.
 - a. Correction #1: <u>Obedience</u> to God's Word and ways is restored.
 - b. Correction #2: Right worship of God is restored.
 - c. Correction #3: Lays aside the robes of the king for the robes of a Levite.
 - d. Result: <u>Deeds</u> of faithfulness lead to further <u>deeds</u> of faithfulness.
- 3. (v.20-23) David disciplines his wife.
 - a. She was her **father's** daughter who worshiped **idols**.
 - b. She loved David the <u>military</u> hero, not David the <u>spiritual</u> hero.
 - c. She was taken without first inquiring of the Lord.
 - Result: This is a picture of the battle between the <u>flesh</u> and Spirit.

Application

- There are those who are sincere in wanting to return spiritually but are <u>unsuccessful</u> because they pursue it not according to God's Word and ways but man's.
- 2. Those who are <u>successful</u> are those who restore obedience to God's Word, right worship, and a greater emphasis on spiritual leadership rather than human leadership.
- 3. The David's are always battling the Michal's within the body because the <u>flesh</u> resists the <u>Spirit</u>.
