## 2 Kings 5:1-19 • God's Conduit

1.	(v.1) Naaman was a conduit of God's working in the world.
2.	(v.2-5) The girl is a conduit of God's <u>message</u> regardless of her circumstances.
3.	(v.6-7) The king of Israel makes no <u>pretense</u> of being a conduit of God.
4.	(v.8-14) Elisha, as a conduit of God, does not operate according to man's wisdom and ways.
5.	(v.15-19) Naaman becomes a greater conduit of God by living in the world but not of the world.
