## 2 Kings 17:7-23 – The Fall of Israel

- 1. (v.7-8) Israel first gave in to the ways of <u>non-believers</u> and then knowingly followed <u>false leaders</u>.
- 2. (v.9-12) Israel's <u>secret</u> unfaithfulness eventually revealed itself <u>openly</u>.
- 3. (v.13) Israel repeatedly failed to respond to God's many opportunities to <u>repent</u> and <u>return</u> to Him.
- (v.14-15) Israel's wholesale <u>rejection</u> of all of God's Word resulted in becoming no different than the <u>unbelievers</u> who surrounded them.
- 5. (v.16-17) Israel did not merely cease to <u>listen</u> to the Lord, but actively <u>embraced</u> the things most hated by God.
- 6. (v.18-23) Israel was not <u>led</u> astray, chose to <u>stay</u> astray.
- 7. Read 2 Kings 23:4-25
