- 1. (1:1-23) The biblical view of the world is through the sons of Noah: Japheth, Ham and Shem.
- 2. (1:24-54) The genealogy of Abraham reminds us that God has a plan for all the peoples of the earth.
- 3. (2) The genealogy Judah provides examples as to the consequences for <u>disobedience</u>.
- 4. (3) The genealogy of David funnels our attention to the messianic seed line.
- 5. (4-8) The genealogies of Israel reflect the changing **spiritual** conditions over time in both the land and the people.
- 6. (9) This genealogy documents the return from the **Babylonian Captivity**.
