2 Chronicles 30 • Returning to the Blood of the Lamb

- 1. (v.1-4) The invitation is for everyone.
- 2. (v.5-9) The invitation addresses the issues of <u>pride</u>, <u>sin</u>, and <u>unfaithfulness</u>.
- 3. (v.10-12) The invitation will not be <u>welcomed</u> by everyone.
- 4. (v.13-15a) It's not a <u>one-time</u> calling, but a <u>permanent</u> calling away from <u>sin</u>.
- 5. (v.15b-20) It's begins with the **blood of the Lamb**.
 - a. 1 Samuel 15:22
 - b. Psalm 51:16-17
- 6. (v.21-31:1) It results in a changed life not just <u>AT church</u> but <u>AWAY from church</u>. Finally rid of <u>sin</u>, they seek to <u>sin</u> no more.
 - It takes place from the heart.
 - It always involved a return to the **blood of the Lamb**.
 - It's followed through with a commitment to <u>God's Word</u> and ways.
 - It results in a permanently changed <u>lifestyle</u>.
