

2 Chronicles 36:11-21 • Leaving God No Alternative

1. (v.11-14) If you're not wholly dedicated to God's Word, it's impossible to be truly sanctified. Everything so compromised will eventually be removed from God's presence.
2. (v.15-17) The question isn't "How can a loving God allow evil?", but it's actually God asking **US**, "Why won't you obey Me and cease from doing evil?"
 - a. To continually reject obeying God's Word is defined by the Bible as despising His Word.
 - b. "Final Judgment" is actually the point when all attempts at reconciliation to God's Word have been exhausted.
3. (v.18-21) We can't pick and choose which parts of God's Word is to be obeyed. This inevitably leads to spiritual deception.
4. The rejection of God's Word works spiritual deception to the point of leaving God no alternative but Final Judgment.
