## Job 3 • When Silence Comes to an End

1.	(v.1-10) Rather than curse God, as Satan predicted and Job's
	wife advocated, Job deflects it to <u>curse</u> the day of his birth.

2. (v.11-19) <u>Death</u> is the great equalizer for everyone regardless of their <u>station</u> in this life.

3. (v.20-26) For believers, the most difficult thing to overcome when experiencing <u>suffering</u> is reconciling it with what we personally know about <u>God</u>, His <u>Word</u>, and His <u>ways</u>.

## **Overall Application**:

From the outset, Job's question is about God's <u>will</u>, not about relief from <u>sin</u>.
