Job 4 • Laying Error Alongside Truth

 (v.1-6) There is a difference between <u>reacting</u> to someone and <u>ministering</u> to them. <u>Reactive</u> measures are most often undertaken based on <u>feelings</u> rather than seeking the Lord's <u>counsel</u>.

2. (v.7-11) One's spiritual walk is not entirely measured by <u>earthly</u> circumstances. What looks like consequences for <u>unfaithfulness</u> may instead be a <u>test</u> of <u>faith</u>.

3. (v.12-21) The lessons God has taught us personally may not universally apply to everyone else. "God told me" is often a way of elevating one's self rather than communicating truth.
