Job 28 • The Pursuit for What Matters

 (v.1-11) Man goes to great lengths and efforts to uncover <u>physical</u> things that are hidden and buried in <u>darkness</u>, bringing them out into the <u>light</u> of his world for his use. This is an allusion to the <u>spiritual</u>.

 (v.12-22) Even the most valuable earthly commodities cannot purchase something that can only be obtained by <u>obedience</u> to God's <u>Word</u>. It does not exist in any form that man can obtain by his own <u>will</u> and <u>effort</u>.

3. (v.23-28) What matters most is <u>fear</u> (extreme <u>regard</u> for) of the <u>Lord</u> and <u>willful</u> separation from <u>sin</u>.
