## Job 30 • Where Are You, God?

- 1. (v.1-8) We can feel distant <u>spiritually</u> when we begin to think we should be better off than <u>others</u>.
- 2. (v.9-15) We can feel distant <u>spiritually</u> when we feel we are being treated as the <u>wicked</u> should be who appear to be better off than <u>us</u>.
- 3. (v.16-23) Even <u>Christ</u> experienced God's <u>silence</u>. (Mt. 27:6) What is often needed most is not a <u>sermon</u> but <u>companionship</u>.
- 4. (v.24-31) It is most often an issue of endurance, not a shortage of faith.

Traumatic events often invoke the **grief** reaction:

- Shock
- Denial
- Anger
- Bargaining
- **Depression**
- Acceptance
