Psalm 44 • In the Midst of It

- 1. (v.1-3) Past success came about not by the <u>works</u> of man but the <u>working</u> of God.
- 2. (v.4-8) Just as the Lord was <u>sovereign</u> and in <u>control</u> in the past, so is He now; just as He provided <u>victory</u> in the past, so is able to provide it now; just as the <u>outcome</u> was in God's hands then, so is the present.
- 3. (v.9-16) We cannot make a judgment about what is happening based solely on the <u>circumstances</u>. It is the same God in charge regardless of external <u>appearances</u> one way or the other.
- (v.17-19) Regardless of external <u>conditions</u> good or bad the overwhelming consideration is to remain spiritually <u>faithful</u> to God's <u>Word</u> and <u>ways</u>.
- 5. (v.20-26) It is not a test of **knowledge** but **faith**; it is not an issue of personal **strength** or **circumstances** but God's **grace**.
