Psalm 49 • How to Preach the Gospel

- (v.1-4) An authentic public witness and testimony has the best chance of being <u>effective</u> when it comes from a faith putting God's <u>Word</u> into practice. To preach the <u>truth</u>, one must live the <u>truth</u>.
- 2. (v.5-9) A biblical public witness and testimony is concerned with the <u>false trust</u> of the things of this life and the <u>consequences</u> for the next.
- (v.10-12) Non-believers need to be <u>challenged</u> to see that the way they seek to make their name and legacy live on in future earthly generations is exactly what <u>Christ</u> offers, except in how and what it is <u>spent</u> on.
- (v.13-15) A biblical public witness and testimony communicates the fact that those who <u>trusted</u> the most in their earthly <u>homes</u> will find none in eternity, while those who places their trust in <u>God</u> are received eternally into <u>His</u>.
- 5. A biblical public witness and testimony is not a call to physical poverty, but to spiritual <u>submission</u>. It is a call to <u>devote</u> all to the Lord so as to both attain a lasting <u>legacy</u> and leave behind something which genuinely <u>matters</u> to others.
