

Psalm 62 • Living with Silence (According to God's Standards)

1. (v.1-2) God is a safe place to trust in while we silently wait.
2. (v.3-4) Outside pressure seems more powerful than it really is when we're silently waiting on God.
 - a. It's difficult to wait in silence because the chief weapon of our enemy is the lie.
3. (v.5-8) We don't just trust God when He says "Yes" or "No", but "Wait" as well.
 - a. It's appropriate to pour out our heart to God while waiting, just not to engage in a dialog that reveals we don't really trust Him.
4. (v.9-10) Earthly pressure often comes from the things it holds important such as personal wealth and power.
5. (v.11-12) Ironically, it's God's Word that comforts and supports us in times of silence.
 - a. "Silence" is not "down time", but being used as a test of faith.
6. Conclusion: One of the reasons God engages us in times of silence is it provides evidence to those around us that God's glory is more important than our own glory.
