## Psalm 73 • My Only Desire on Earth

1.	(v.1-9) We are in danger of <u>slipping</u> when our <u>sight</u> is not fixed on the <u>eternal</u> but is allowed to be distracted by the <u>temporal</u> .
2.	(v.10-14) Sometimes it does not appear that God is <u>rewarding</u> or <u>responding</u> to the right people.
3.	(v.15-20) Such personal struggles cannot be settled in our own strength, but in the course of bringing them before God.
4.	(v.21-24) God allows us to come to Him with our <u>mixed</u> feelings and will help us deal with them as long as we remain with <u>Him</u> and do not <u>leave</u> to <u>pursue</u> them.
5.	(v.25-28) The biblically faithful are more concerned for God's <a href="mailto:name">name</a> and <a href="mailto:glory">glory</a> far and above their <a href="mailto:own">own</a> .
