# Psalms 95-100 • The Messiah in the Psalms

### **Psalm 95**

The Messiah is <u>equal to God</u>. He was supposed to be the <u>Shepherd</u> accepted by Israel the <u>flock</u>, leading them into His place of rest as when He led them out of Egypt to Canaan. (From the old life to the new.)

#### <u>Psalm 96</u>

The Messiah will be the <u>Judge</u> the whole world according to the standard of <u>God's Word</u>. Israel was supposed to <u>consecrate</u> themselves to accept Him according to that standard.

#### **Psalm 97**

The Messiah will be <u>King</u> over each individual <u>heart</u>. Israel was to experience <u>spiritual revival</u> at His coming.

#### Psalm 98

The Messiah will be the <u>Savior</u> of the whole world. God's <u>plan of salvation</u> was to be revealed by the Messiah to the whole world through Israel.

## **Psalm 99**

The Messiah will by <u>holy</u> but <u>accessible</u>. He would remove all obstacles so that everyone could <u>worship and serve</u> Him at the <u>holy of holies</u>.

## <u>Psalm 100</u>

The Messiah will work <u>righteousness</u> and <u>faithfulness</u> from the heart. His people's <u>lifestyle</u> and <u>behavior</u> would be visibly changed.

### **Overall**

Although rejected by Israel, Jesus fulfilled all these things in His First Coming for His **Gentile Bride**; He will still fulfill all these things at His Second Coming for His **Jewish Bride**.
