## Psalm 115 • You Are What You Worship

- 1. (v.1-8) It begins with God's **lovingkindness** and **truth**.
  - a. "Lovingkindness" = God's determination to keep His promises in spite of sin and rebellion.
  - b. "Truth" = God's Word.
- 2. God <u>breathes life</u> into those conformed to His image; there is <u>no life</u> in those conformed to their own image.
- 3. You become what you worship: a <u>living creation</u> of God's hand or a <u>lifeless creation</u> of man's.
- 4. (v.9-15) It builds upon trust in God's <a href="help">help</a> and <a href="protection">protection</a> rather than man's.
- 5. Adherence to lovingkindness and truth is what leads to spiritual <a href="blessings">blessings</a>.
- 6. (v.16-18) We are only responsible to worship that which has been revealed to us.
  - a. Our worship in <u>this life</u> is but a beginning which extends into <u>the next</u>.
  - b. Like our God, our worship is alive and eternal.
- 7. **Overall**: Right worship on earth is a kind of "rehearsal" to learning our heavenly role for eternity. (Note: This is why God sees those as not having yet chosen Him as "dead".)
