## Proverbs 11-21 • References to "The LORD"

1.	The Sovereignty of the Lord: Nothing will ever result from a
	relationship with God if it doesn't proceed from our absolute
	acknowledgment that our will must be subordinate to His will
	our ways to His. Everything else proceeds from this point first.

2. The Fear of the Lord: To "fear the LORD" is to apply the knowledge of God's authority and divinity to our daily life, living to please Him rather than our self.

3. **The Heart of the Lord**: The true measure of someone who embraces God's sovereignty and biblically fears him is proven by their degree of **faithfulness** from the **heart**.

4. <u>The Abomination to the Lord</u>: God has made known those things which are absolutely <u>off-limits</u> and <u>offensive</u> to Him.
