

Isaiah 25 • Living Today for Tomorrow

1. (v.1-5) It begins by seeing God's promised future as already **fulfilled** because of His past promises already **fulfilled**.

2. (v.6-8) In the promised life to come:
 - a. He will "*prepare a lavish **banquet***". (v.6)

 - b. He will "*swallow up the **covering**...over all peoples*" (v.7)

 - c. He will "*swallow up **death** for all time*". (v.8)

 - d. He will "*wipe **tears** away from all faces*". (v.8)

 - e. He will "*remove the **reproach** of His people*". (v.8)

3. (v.9-12) In the end, those who will be able to **rejoice** will be those who have **endured** and **obeyed** while living out the belief of His actual **return**.
