Isaiah 46-54 • On the Other Side of Judgment

- 1. (46:1-2) The spiritual <u>weight</u> of idolatry is represented by the real <u>weight</u> of those idols on our <u>shoulders</u>.
- 2. (46:3-4) God's willingness is not to be a spiritual <u>burden</u> upon us but to bear the <u>burden</u> Himself.
- 3. (Mt. 23:1-4) Man's religion has the same effect as idolatry.
- 4. (49:6) The work of God to be <u>fulfilled</u> through Israel will come through the <u>Messiah</u>.
- 5. (49:14-16) It is God's faithfulness and remembrance of His own Word which reconciles.
- 6. (49:22-26) God's repeated "<u>resurrection</u>" of Israel is a precursor as well as testimony to the <u>resurrection</u> of Christ, and the power and work of the <u>resurrection</u> in those who follow Him.
- 7. (52:7-10) The "<u>resurrection</u>" of Israel has the greater aim, "That all the ends of the earth may see the salvation of God".
- 8. (52:13-15) The Messiah came through <u>Israel</u> and initiated a work that is still to be completed through <u>Israel</u>.
- 9. (54:9-10) When God's people return to Him, what awaits them is grace, peace and compassion.
