Isaiah 51 • How to Pursue God

- 1. (v.1-3) What we pursue we usually **get**. The **goal** of those who pursue the Lord is **righteousness**.
- 2. (v.4-8) Those who pursue God embrace His <u>Word</u> and <u>ways</u> while shrinking from those of man's. They see the reality of the godly pursuit, which is <u>permanent</u>, versus the earthly pursuit which is <u>temporary</u>.
- 3. (v.9-11) Those who pursue God may not immediately be <u>freed</u> from the <u>enslavement</u> of earthly circumstances, but they have the assurance of God which is a <u>future</u> as sure as if it already happened in the <u>past</u> that they will be. They know to <u>Whom</u> they actually belong.
- 4. (v.12-16) The pursuit of God is not strictly limited to the things and events we see here on <u>earth</u>; they have corresponding effects and connections to things in the <u>heavenly</u> realm as well. This is why they replace their <u>fear</u> of men with a <u>fear</u> of the Lord.
- 5. (v.17-20) Those who pursue God don't have to learn things the hard way by God's discipline.
- 6. (v.21-23) Those who pursue God will not continue forever in being oppressed by the people and institutions of this present world.
