Jeremiah 27-28 • When the False Prophet Meets the True

- (27:1-2) Jeremiah does something which visibly <u>parallels</u> the greater <u>symbolism</u> of God's Word; this is called an <u>object</u> <u>lesson</u>.
- 2. (27:3-7) The meaning of the object lesson is what will happen to the nations.
- (27:8-11) One of the ways people rebel against God is by seeking <u>false</u> spiritual authorities to tell them what they want to <u>hear</u> rather than the <u>truth</u>. The greater problem here is with people who will <u>listen</u> to every spiritual <u>deceiver</u> of every kind but not to the <u>Word of God</u>.
- (27:12-15) The <u>difference</u> between putting into practice God's Word and ways as opposed to listening to false spiritual influences is literally the <u>difference</u> between <u>life</u> and <u>death</u> itself.
- (27:16-22) When the things of God are continually <u>misused</u> they are <u>withdrawn</u> by God so that He can place the focus squarely on the <u>heart</u>.
- 6. (28:1-4) The true role of a <u>biblical</u> prophet is to <u>call</u> God's backslidden people <u>back</u> into a right spiritual relationship with Him. Therefore the true working of a <u>false</u> prophet is to

- persuade God's backslidden people that there is <u>no need</u> to repent or reconcile spiritually.
- 7. (28:5-9) False prophets often confuse the issue by turning the true message of God around to mean its exact opposite.
- 8. (28:10-11) A true prophet is careful to speak only as God <u>directs</u> an no further.
- (28:12-17) One of the ways we can know for sure that a false prophet is at work is in the fact that their <u>adherents</u> do not <u>change</u> according to God's Word and ways but seek to <u>justify</u> and <u>continue</u> their own earthly and fleshly ways.
- 10. <u>Overall</u>: A true prophet is someone who is <u>calling</u> God's backslidden people <u>back</u> into a right relationship with Him. The event the prophet predicts is most often a milestone when <u>time</u> runs out, when it will be <u>too late</u> to effectually repent and return to God.
