## Jeremiah 29:1-20 • Our Hope & Future

(v.1-9) Judgment doesn't actually "end" when the physical acts
of judgment are completed, but only when God's PURPOSE for
judgment has been accomplished. He doesn't want punished
people, He wants people who RESPOND to punishment and
return in sincere repentance and commitment from the heart.

2. (v.10-14) They are going through God's judgment in order to be refined and changed into the kind of people who will conform to His plans for their hope and future. Becoming what God intends involves a personal commitment of faithfulness and obedience to His Word and ways on our part.

3. (v.15-20) In spite of one's past <u>record</u> of faithfulness, the only way forward is to reject the <u>false</u> word for the <u>true</u>.
