Ezekiel 2-3 • When God Calls a True Prophet

- (2:1-7) True biblical prophets act like <u>evangelists</u>, only to God's people. They are reaching out to those steeped in <u>sin</u>, calling them back to the Lord. Just like <u>evangelists</u>, they have to keep their spiritual <u>integrity</u> intact, resisting against becoming like those around them and reaching out to everyone whether or not God's <u>message</u> through them is <u>accepted</u>.
- (2:8-3:3) Whereas false prophets try to <u>pervert</u> God's Word or <u>add</u> to it in some manner, true prophets always live according to it and their message can be <u>corroborated</u> according to God's Word.
- (3:4-11) God's prophets exhibit the ultimate commitment to the
 <u>Truth</u> because they are sent to a people whose number one
 problem is willful and conscious rejection of the <u>Truth</u>. It's only
 when they finally return to the <u>Truth</u> that everything else will
 follow spiritually.
- 4. (3:12-15) True prophets speak, appear, and work only when and where God <u>designates</u>. There is no biblical precedent for them holding <u>rallies</u> or <u>assemblies</u> or weekly <u>television</u> shows. If not directed by God to speak, they will <u>wait</u> for **HIS** time and place.

5. (3:16-21) Prophets aren't allowed to just make predictions and leave; they are called to be a living example among those to whom they're called, providing direction how to live properly at the time those predictions come about. A true prophet is not strictly a messenger, but a living example of the message.

6. (3:22-27) A summary of a true prophet's calling & ministry:

- a. (v.22-23) <u>Humbled</u> in the presence of God.
- b. (v.24) Established and empowered by the **Spirit**.
- c. (v.24) Will meet <u>resistance</u> to his ministry by those he is sent to.
- d. (v.26-27) <u>Speaks</u> only when directed by God, sticking strictly to God's Word.
- e. (v.27) The results of his ministry are a <u>mirror</u> of the spiritual condition of those to whom he is sent.
- f. (Rev. 22:11)
