Ezekiel 33 • God's Watchman

- 1. (v.1-6) The role of God's watchman is to warn of God's judgment.
- 2. (v.7-9) The responsibility of the watchman is **communication**.
- 3. (v.10-11) The message of the watchman is first and foremost <u>a</u> <u>call to repentance</u>.
- 4. (v.12-16) The only guarantee God provides to either the righteous or the wicked is <u>salvation</u> through <u>obedience</u>.
- 5. (v.17-20) Biblically there is no such thing as guilt by <u>association</u>, only guilt by <u>cooperation</u>. The same goes for righteousness.
- 6. (v.23-26) The purpose of judgment is to either change <u>hearts</u> or destroy those <u>hearts</u> which refuse to change.
- 7. (v.30-33) Acknowledging a watchman and his message is of no value if the listener does not repent and change their ways.

Examples of a "good" or "bad" watchman:

- 1. Mt. 24:42-44: The watchman of the house.
- 2. Mt. 24:45-51: The watchman of the household.
- 3. Mt. 25:1-13: The watchman of the return of **Christ**.
- 4. Mt. 25:14-30: The accountability of the watchman to **everyone** at large.
- 5. Mt. 25:31-46: The watchman defined by putting <u>God's Word</u> into practice.
