## Ezekiel 43 • Where is the Glory of the Lord?

- 1. (9:3; 10:1-5, 18-19; 11:23) The <u>departure</u> of the glory of the Lord.
- 2. (43:1-2) The <u>return</u> of the glory of the Lord.
  - a. Christ will return in the same manner as <a href="He left">He left</a>. (Acts 1:9-11)
  - b. Christ will return to the Temple through the **East Gate**.
  - c. The glory of the Lord visited earth briefly in the form of <a href="Christ's First Coming">Christ's First Coming</a>. (Mt. 17:1-2; Jn. 1:14)
  - d. The glory of the Lord currently resides as the resurrected Christ. (Rev.1:12-16)
  - e. Sometimes the glory of the Lord is <u>visibly imparted</u> to believers. (Acts 6:8, 15)
  - f. At all times the glory of the Lord currently dwells in the New Testament Temple. (1 Cor. 3:16; 6:19)
  - g. The thing that prevents the glory of the Lord from being seen is most often <u>sin</u>. Believers need to:
    - 1. Put away every sin.
    - 2. Put away every doubtful thing.
    - 3. Love as Christ loved.
    - 4. Pray without ceasing.
    - 5. Be cleansed by the washing of the **Word**.
    - 6. Live by <u>faith</u> alone.
