Daniel 11-12 • Kings Giving Way to THE King

- 1. (11:1-28) These are events <u>literally</u> fulfilled during the reign of the Ptolemy's in Egypt and the Seleucid's in Syria.
- (11:29-35) These are events are <u>partially</u> fulfilled during the reign of Antiochus Epiphanes IV. The events related to the <u>Maccabean Revolt</u> will be recapitulated by the final Antichrist.
- 3. (11:36-39) These events are <u>yet to come</u>. They mainly focus on the final Antichrist's rebellion against **God**.
- 4. (11:40-45) These events are <u>yet to come</u>. They mainly focus on the final Antichrist's rebellion against <u>mankind</u>.
- 5. (12:1-4) The basic structure of the End Times from Daniel's perspective:
 - a. **The Suffering**. (v.1) [Mt. 24:21]
 - b. <u>The Separation</u>. (v.2) [1 Th. 4:16; 1 Co. 15:51; Acts 24:15; Rev. 20:5]
 - c. **The Shining**. (v.3) [Mt. 13:37-43]
 - d. The Sealing. (v.4) [Rev. 5:1; 22:10]
- 6. (12:5-7) The Great Tribulation is really <u>earthly</u> events mirroring the final <u>spiritual</u> battle.
- 7. (12:8-13) It is ultimately all a test for <u>everyone</u>. For the "wicked" these events <u>judge</u> and <u>condemn</u> them; for the "righteous" these events <u>purify</u> and <u>refine</u> them.

Application: The private struggle for each **individual** as to whether or not to serve the One True God is played out in the End Times on the public, worldwide **stage**.
