## Zechariah 1-2 • The First Three Visions

- (1:1-6) God's Word will inevitably hold us accountable in the <u>present</u> and for the <u>future</u> just as it has assuredly held everyone and everything accountable in the <u>past</u>.
- 2. (1:7-11) No matter how "good" things appear from either the world's or Satan's point of view no matter how spiritually dark things get, God is still active and at work.
- (1:12-17) God is active and in control not just of the <u>local</u> situation, but the whole <u>world</u>. His greater goals all have to do with the greater work of spiritual <u>faithfulness</u> and a <u>return</u> to His Word and ways more than just a <u>return</u> to a geographical location.
- 4. (1:18-21) God is not just in control and has a plan for the whole world, He is in control and has a plan for His enemies.
- 5. (2:1-5) The <u>literal</u> is an allusion to the <u>spiritual</u>.
- 6. (2:6-13) God the Father is not at work just to restore <u>Israel</u>, but to restore the entire <u>world</u>.

<u>Overall</u>: God is watching, patrolling, and already has in place the power and resources to <u>fulfill</u> His <u>promises</u>. Whether in <u>times</u> of trial or blessing, the measure of our success is based on the quality of our <u>faithfulness</u>.
