## Zechariah 3 • The Work of the Son

- (v.1-2) The issue of sin and judgment is not strictly limited to something that takes place on <u>earth</u>; it is a core issue in <u>heaven</u> between Satan and Christ Himself. While there will ultimately be a Final Judgment, in the meantime there is a <u>struggle</u> between Satan the Accuser and Christ our Advocate. The first work of Christ is <u>salvation</u>.
- 2. (v.3-5) The subsequent work of Christ is <u>sanctification</u>, the process of making us <u>holy</u> and <u>acceptable</u> for God's service.
- 3. (v.6-7) The <u>expectation</u> is that once someone has come into a personal relationship with Christ that they will no longer live according to their old <u>way of life</u> but by putting His Word and ways into practice. Spiritual faithfulness reflects the believer's position *both* in the <u>earthly</u> and <u>heavenly</u> scheme of things.
- 4. (v.8-10) The work of the earthly <u>priesthood</u> and the earthly <u>temple</u> foreshadows the greater work of Christ the <u>High Priest</u> and the <u>priesthood</u> of all believers to come. Service in the Kingdom of God is not limited to events on <u>earth</u> but reflects a greater <u>heavenly</u> work.

**Overall**: Sometimes we differentiate between the <u>daily grind</u> of life on earth from "what will come" in the <u>future</u> in heaven, but our service <u>here</u> is already being reflected <u>there</u>.
