Zechariah 7 • True Obedience

1.	(v.1-3) Biblical obedience cannot come from someone who treats their faith like a <u>iob</u> instead of <u>a way of life</u> .
2.	(v.4-7) Biblical obedience cannot come from someone who witnesses God at work but is not personally transformed by it.
3.	(v.8-10) Obedience to the <u>first tablet</u> ("loving God") is impossible without obedience to the <u>second tablet</u> ("loving others").
4.	(v.11-12) The disobedient are <u>incapable</u> of understanding or applying the Word of God due to their own <u>behavior</u> .
5.	(v.13-14) If we do not change our own behavior , we will find ourselves just like the disobedient, who only call on God to get what they want . We should be just as obedient in times of stress the same as we are in times of peace .
