Matthew 6 • Practicing Our Righteousness

- 1. (5:48) We are to be complete in that our heart and mind are in accord with God's Word.
- 2. (v.1) Are we intent on **glorifying** God or bringing **glory** to our self?
- 3. (v.2-4) In all things we are to be a visible <u>witness</u> for Christ, not ourselves.
- 4. (v.5-6) In all things we are to be a <u>witness</u> for Christ from the heart.
- 5. (v.7-13) Righteousness is reflected in the quality of one's prayer when it seeks God's will above one's own desires.
 - a. Proper prayer acknowledges God's <u>sovereignty</u> and <u>authority</u>. (v.9)
 - b. Proper prayer seeks to build God's <u>kingdom</u> on earth, not our own. (v.10)
 - c. Proper prayer seeks God's will, not our own. (v.10)
 - d. Proper prayer seeks what we <u>need</u>, not what we <u>want</u>.(v.11)
 - e. Proper prayer seeks forgiveness not just of sin within us, but against us. (v.12)
 - f. Proper prayer seeks to avoid the opportunity for <u>sin</u>.(v.13)
- 6. (v.14-15) Biblical righteousness is closely associated with **forgiveness**.

- 7. (v.15-18) Biblical righteousness begins on the most <u>personal</u> level before it becomes visibly, externally <u>evident</u>.
- 8. (v.19-21) Biblical righteousness is characterized by a <u>fixation</u> not on this life but the one to come.
- 9. (v.22-23) Biblical righteousness is focused on the right, heavenly things rather than temporal, earthly things.
- 10. (v.24-30) Biblical righteousness exercises faith in God for all **earthly** matters.
- 11. (v.31-33) The biblically righteous are visibly <u>discernible</u> from worldly people.
 - a. Following God's laws (Mt. 5) externally instead of from the heart is the difference between someone focused n an <u>earthly</u> life versus <u>heavenly</u>.
 - Public vs. private display of Christian characteristics and activities is the difference between a "hypocrite" (earth-focused) and a true believer (heaven-focused).
 - c. The difference between being perfect/complete as our Father is whether we seek <u>HIS</u> kingdom and righteousness or our <u>own</u>.
 - d. Spiritual obedience results in BOTH earthly and heavenly <u>security</u> and fulfills the whole of God's Law: this is <u>biblical righteousness</u>.
