Matthew 14 • A Picture of This Age

 (v.1-12) Those faithful to the Word of God will <u>suffer</u> <u>persecution</u> because the world which has <u>rejected</u> the King will also <u>rejects</u> His messengers.

2. (v.13-21) For those faithful in conveying the Word of God, Christ will meet every <u>provision</u> necessary to complete their <u>ministry</u>.

3. (v.22-36) For those faithful to the Word of God, Christ's protection is ultimately experienced regardless of the appearance of circumstances. It's not about knowledge, but faith.

This Present Age:

- Those to whom the King originally came <u>reject</u> Him.
- The King <u>withdraws</u> and there is <u>persecution</u> against His servants.
- Through His servants the King distributes the **Bread of life** to a hungry world.
- The King's servants go through **storms and testing**.
- Christ returns to give them <u>peace</u> and rescue them from the <u>enemy</u>.
