## Matthew 15:29-16:12 • On Whose Terms?

1.	(15:29-31) It begins with recognizing someone greater than one's self is needed to meet their needs.
2.	(15:32-39) The Father has sufficient <u>resources</u> in spite of our earthly perspective to the <u>contrary</u> .
3.	(16:1-4) Miracles are only effective to actually <u>change</u> someone for those who accept the greater <u>message</u> accompanying them.
4.	(16:5-12) It is not <u>miracles</u> which multiply into a revival, but the acceptance and working of the <u>Word</u> of Christ, first through the <u>Gospel</u> message, and then as a sign of true repentance to put it into <u>practice</u> .
