Matthew 21:23-22:14 • Three Parables for Israel

- 1. (23:23-27) God does not reveal new <u>truth</u> until we obey what has already been <u>revealed</u>.
- 2. (23:28-32) God measures righteousness not by what one <u>says</u> but by what one <u>does</u>.
- 3. (23:33-46) God the <u>Father</u> can never be reached without coming to Him through God the <u>Son</u>.
- 4. (22:1-14) Rejection of God's <u>Word</u> is rejection of Christ Himself and comes with permanent, eternal <u>consequences</u>.

The overall spiritual history of Israel:

- The Parable of the Two Sons: She disobeyed the <u>Father</u>.
- The Parable of the Vineyard: She crucified the **Son**.
- The Parable of the Marriage Feast: She resisted the **Spirit**.
- She was chosen by God to be <u>fruitful</u> but failed to <u>bear fruit</u>.
- This is actually a picture of the meaning of "apostasy", what it means for someone to "fall away".
