## Mark 8 • The Work of the Suffering Servant

- 1. (v.1-9) <u>Compassion</u>: The Suffering Servant comes to <u>fulfill</u> God's plan to the whole world.
- (v.10-21) <u>Concern</u>: The Suffering Servant comes with a greater <u>burden</u> that everyone should understand and accept His <u>message</u>.
- 3. (v.22-26) <u>Condemnation</u>: The Suffering Servant's <u>work</u> simultaneously <u>rewards</u> belief and <u>judges</u> unbelief.
- 4. (v.27-33) <u>Crucifixion</u>: The Suffering Servant comes to <u>pay</u> the <u>price</u> of sin.
- 5. (v.34-38) <u>Consecration</u>: The Suffering Servant does not come to make <u>converts</u> but <u>disciples</u>.
  - a. True discipleship:
    - 1) We must <u>surrender</u> ourselves completely to Him.
    - 2) We must identify with Him in suffering and death.
    - 3) We must **follow** Him obediently wherever He leads.
