Mark 12:13-34 • Three Types of Challengers

- 1. (v.13-17) How to deal with hypocrites.
 - a. Make a distinction between the things of <u>God</u> and the things of this <u>world</u>.
 - b. They must <u>choose</u> between the things of this life or the next.
 - c. We are most like Pharisees when we seek to make this life better at the expense of <u>others</u>.
- 2. (v.18-27) How to deal with the deceived.
 - a. **Directly**, with the truth of God's Word.
 - b. They must stop using the things of <u>God</u> to justify things in this life.
 - c. We are most like Sadducees when we seek to be "right" in our arguments at the expense of our love.
- 3. (v.28-34) How to deal with the true seeker.
 - a. Enable them to seek God on God's terms rather than their own.
 - b. They need to be <u>affirmed</u> to seek the things of God.
 - c. We are most like the scribe when we seek to personally apply <u>God's Word</u>.
- 4. How do these attributes compare with Christ's admonition in last week's reading to come to Him as a **child** and aspire to become a **servant**?
