Mark 14:1-42 • Preparing for God's Will

- 1. (v.1-2) <u>The Authorities Prepare Their Own Plan</u>: Man makes plans according to his own <u>will</u>; where appropriate God causes them to be conformed to His <u>will</u>.
- (v.3-9) God's Preparation for His Own Plan: Every heart makes a choice to either support and follow Christ in <u>love</u> and <u>obedience</u> or to work against Him according to rebellious <u>self-interest</u>.
- 3. (v.10-11) <u>Man's Preparations</u>: Where Christ is concerned every heart will be a <u>sell-out</u> to the world or <u>sold out</u> exclusively for Him stemming from their free will of <u>choice</u>.
- (v.12-16) <u>The Messiah's Preparations</u>: Where Christ is concerned we must follow through in our personal choice and actions to live <u>in concert</u> with His will for our individual life in accordance with His greater <u>purposes</u>.
- 5. (v.17-21) <u>Preparing Those in Rejection of Christ</u>: We can choose to either be <u>willing</u> or <u>unwilling</u> participants where God's Word and will is concerned, but it will be <u>fulfilled</u> regardless.
- 6. (v.22-26) <u>Preparing Those in Acceptance of Christ</u>: Christ provided the Church with a reminder that by personal <u>choice</u> and the application of <u>faith</u> each believer participates in God's salvific plan both for this <u>life</u> and the <u>next</u>.
- (v.27-31) <u>Knowing What Will Happen vs. What Is Intended</u>: We do not have to be <u>perfect</u> in order to accomplish God's will through us because there is always restoration through <u>repentance</u> and <u>obedience</u> to His Word.

- (v.32-42) <u>In the Midst of Knowing God's Will</u>: Through Christ's personal example we understand that although God's will has a plan for our life, it is our own <u>choice</u> as to whether it will be <u>voluntarily</u> accomplished through us.
- 9. **Application**: The tension between free will and God's foreordained plans are to be kept in **equal** balance, neither actually contradicting the other. We are called but choose whether or not to **heed** that call. If we choose our own way God will **use** those ill intentions to accomplish His will anyway.
